by special warrant articles and other appropriations voted separately, the amounts set forth on the budget posted with the warrant, or as amended by vote of the first session, for the purposes set forth therein, totaling \$21,659,174. (twenty-one million, six hundred fifty-nine thousand, one hundred seventy-four dollars)? Should this article be defeated, the default budget shall be \$21,869,804. (twenty-one million, eight hundred sixty-nine thousand, eight hundred four dollars), which is the same as last year, with certain adjustments required by previous action of the Raymond School District or by law; or the governing body may hold one special meeting, in accordance with RSA 40:13, X and XVI, to take up the issue of a revised operating budget only. ARTICLE 3 Shall the School District vote to approve the cost items included in the collective bargaining agreement reached between the Raymond School Board and the Raymond Education Association, which calls for the following increases in salaries and benefits at the current staffing levels:
